



2011 WORLD SERIES

Global Sports Baseball is a division of USSSA Baseball for ages 7 - 14.

Global Sports Registration - All Global Sports teams must be USSSA Registered. The fee is \$15 added to your USSSA registration in order to be eligible for Global Sports Events.

Teams must registered with USSSA and Global Sports to participate in a Global Qualifier. All team participating in a Global Qualifier earn a berth to a Global Sports World Series as long as the team participates in its home USSSA or Global State Tournament.

Teams may enter a Global Sports World Series starting on Monday, January 17th, 2011 on a first come, first served basis. Teams do not have to be qualified at the time of entry but must have played in a Global Sports qualifier by June 15, 2011 and must also play in it home USSSA or Global State Tournament to validate entry. The cost of entering is \$695

Global Sports World Series - will be conducted from Wednesday - Sunday and will guarantee each team 7 games (average). The events will have a unique Tournament format with teams splitting into Red, White, and Blue divisions. All 3 divisions will be crowned World Series Champions. There are a limited number of teams that will qualify and enter each GS World Series.

Global Sports Rosters - Your team will use their USSSA Roster and will be allowed 2 write in players at the event.

Ages 7, 8, 9,10, 11, 12, 13 and 14

24 Teams per age group

7 game guarantee (average) for all teams

Opening ceremonies on Wednesday

Pool play begins on Thursday

Championship play begins on Saturday and concludes on Sunday

3 World Series champions crowned - Red, White and Blue Championships

Teams play 4 pool play games and then seeded into championship play

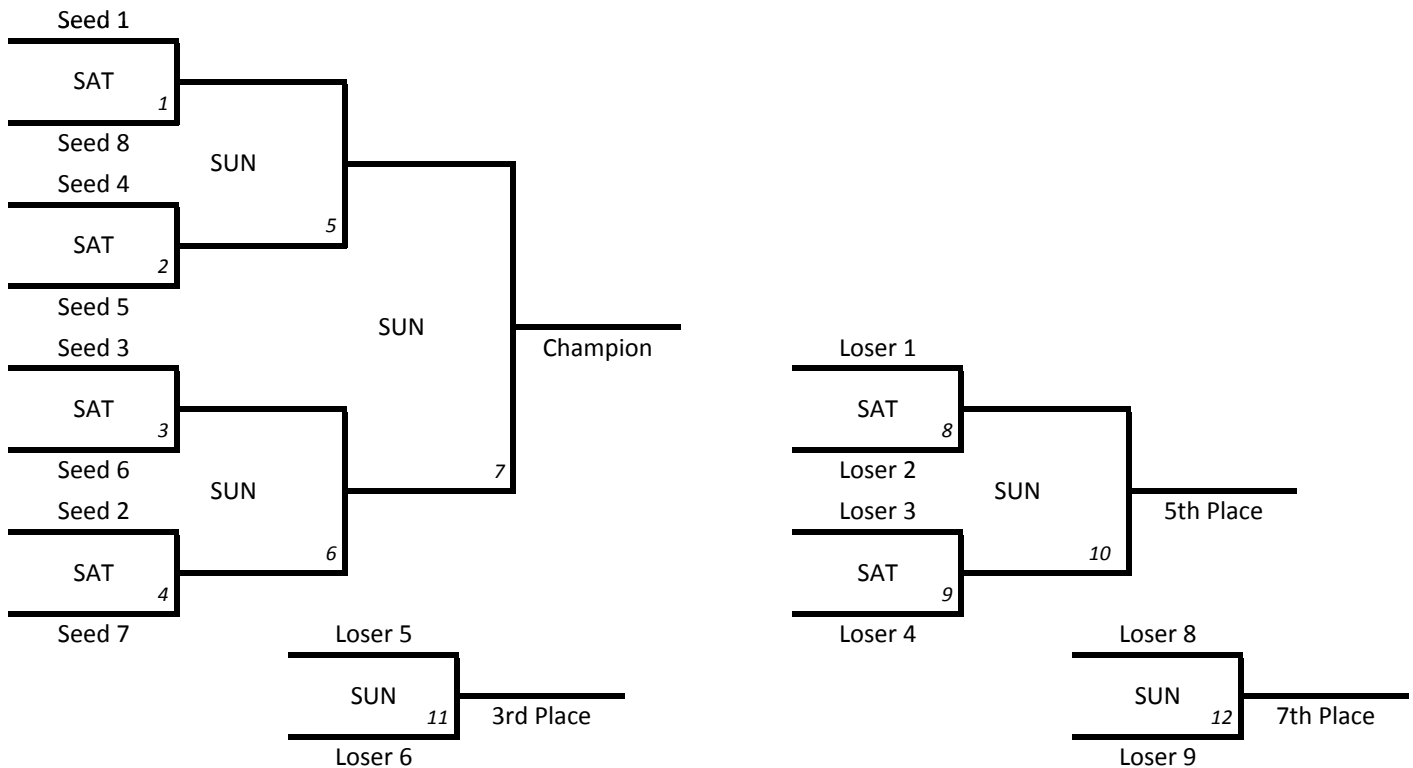


POOL PLAY

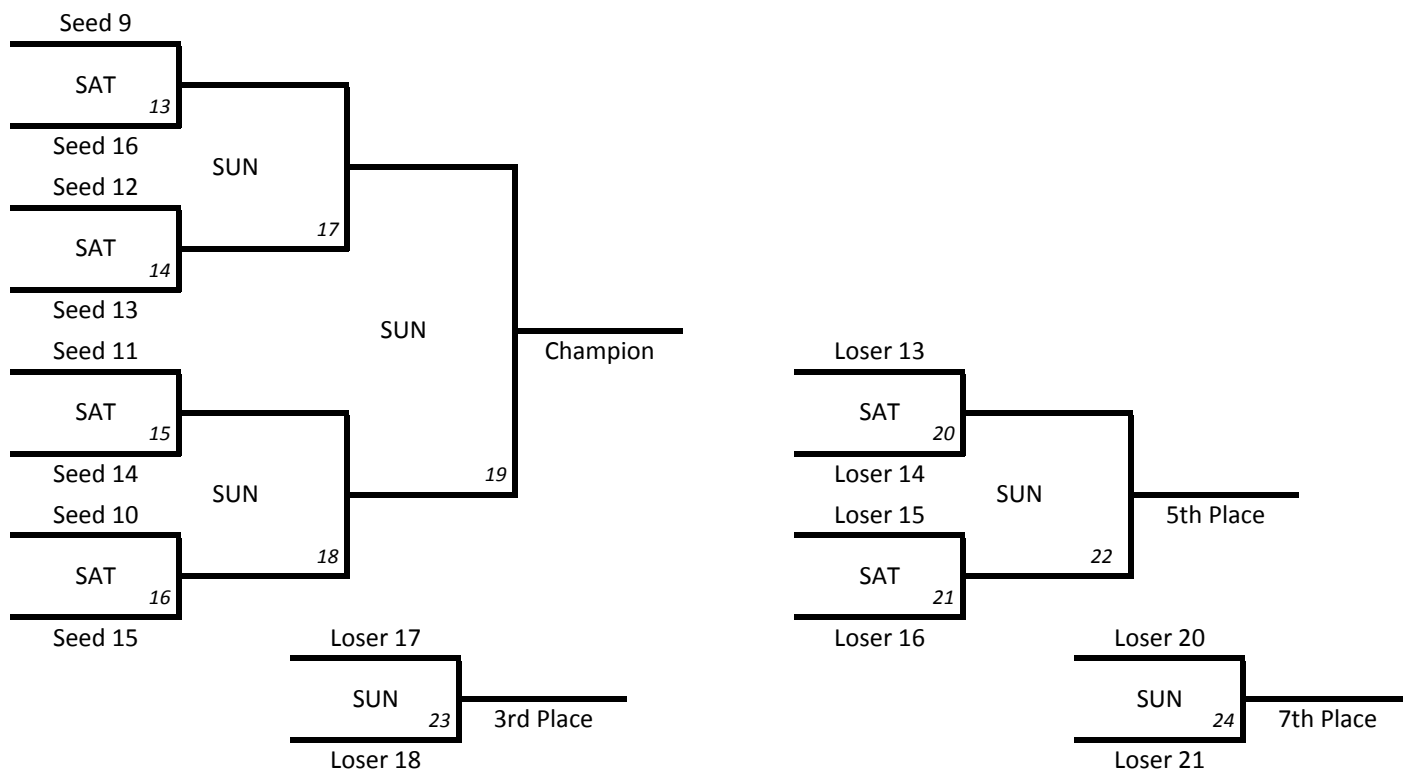
All teams will play 4 games within pool play. After pool play is complete, teams will be seeded 1 - 24 and seeded into a championship bracket. Seeding is based on USSSA pool play / tie breaker criteria.

Pool seeding will be based on 1) USSSA classification, 2) USSSA Points, 3) Geographical location. The tournament director will have the final decision on seeding teams into pool play.
